The Wright County Board of Adjustment met at 7:00 pm in the Supervisor's room in the basement of the Courthouse. The following members were present: Jim Sellers, Jerry Caylor, Jerry Maier and Kathy Waddell, Zoning Administrator. Carl Wibholm was absent.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss an application for a variance to install a garage at Lake Cornelia (parcel # 07-16-202-029). The zoning ordinance states that the lot size must have a minimum of 5,000 square feet and any building must be 20' from the road.

After much discussion, a phone call was made to the McLaughlin's to get clarification on some of the questions the Board had. It was then decided the Maier and the Zoning Administrator will go out and measure when the rain quits.
